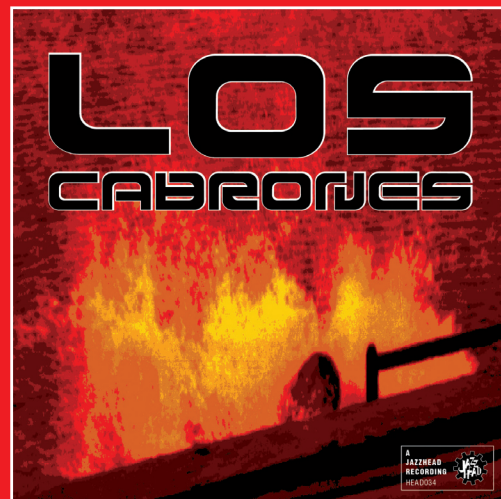




# LOS CABRONES



Australia's premier Afro-Cuban Latin-jazz group, the 15 piece, LOS CABRONES, release their long awaited debut featuring all original compositions.

Formed in '95, LOS CABRONES influence stems from the music of Cuba and the Latin-jazz of New York City from masters including; Tito Puente, Eddie Palmieri, Poncho Sanchez and Son 14 combined with the rich sounds from Melbourne's original jazz/music scene.

Six horns, and a nine piece rhythm section, including five percussionists, sees the impressive LOS CABRONES playing to packed houses, thrilling audiences, wherever they perform.
